## **MEETING MATTERS**

Council would like to thank the Rankins Springs Golf Course Committee for hosting the August Council meeting where the following items were considered:

## **Fixing Local Roads Round One**

The four stage plan for the construction of Carrathool Road under the Fixing Local Roads program was submitted to Council and adopted with works to commence once the grant agreement is executed. Stage one of the plan will see a further 5km sealed from the most recently completed section.

## Heavy Vehicle Permit Process & Route Assessment

A report on Heavy Vehicle permits and routes was considered with Council approving an application to the NHVR, to increase the number of roads within the shire to improve heavy vehicle connectivity to the regional and state road network.

## **Roads to Recovery Additional Funding**

Council approved to undertake sealing works on Lachlan River Road west to east, engaging a contractor on Council's preferred list of suppliers to undertake the construction works.

## **Carrathool Bridge Maintenance Agreement**

Council moved that a maintenance agreement would be entered into with Murrumbidgee Council for the maintenance of the Carrathool Bridge.

## **Plant Tenders and Quotations**

Two tenders and five quotations were approved for the replace of plant items at a cost of approximately one million dollars.

#### DA2020-031 Weather Watch Radar Tower

Council resolved to grant development consent to DA2020-031 construction of a Weather Watch Radar Tower located on the Kidman Way.

## **Delivery Plan Performance Report**

A Delivery Plan Performance report on the progress of the principal activities in the Delivery Program was received by Council.
