NEW SHIRE ENTRY AND TOWN SIGNS

Council was able to purchase and install new shire entry and town signs courtesy of the NSW Government Stronger Country Communities Fund, Round 2.



The design selected for the signs reflects the "red earth" which is common across the Shire, against a background of old weathered boards which were used for many of our older buildings. The main element of the sign depicts a rusted steel effect which once again shows our strong links back to older farming times.

Signs are currently being placed at the entrances to all our towns and villages, as well at the Shire boundaries.

The signs were chosen after a community consultation on Facebook and in Council Corner. To be involved in future community consultations email Council and become part of our Neighbourhood Thoughts Group.

MEETING MATTERS

Hillston Hogs Rugby Club

Council resolved to waive the fees for the use of the Stan Peters Oval for the Annual charity match to be held on 13 February 2021.

Support for Cancer Treatment Centre

At the October meeting it was noted that a letter of support has been sent to the Federal Minister of Health the Hon Greg Hunt regarding creation of a cancer treatment centre in Griffith. This follows a request for support from Griffith City Councils Mayor Cr Dal Broi.

Rankins Springs Potable Water Connections

It was resolved to waive the connection fee for households connecting to the new Rankins Springs village potable supply if they already have a raw water connection.

Remote Airstrip Upgrade Program (RAUP)

Council have instructed the General Manager to make an application under the current round of the RAUP for up to \$150,000 to reseal the Hillston Airstrip.

Economic Development Officers Report

The Economic Development Officers (EDO) report outlined to Council plans to create a community quiet space in Settlers Park, Goolgowi, with concept plans and costings to be drawn up and brought back to Council for consideration. The EDO also informed Council of an offer from the Rotary Club of Griffith Avanti to donate a public BBQ to be installed in the park.

After the success of last year's Pool Parties at the Goolgowi and Hillston Swimming Pools it has been proposed to once again host the parties including providing a bus for residents from Carrathool, Rankins Springs and Merriwagga to join in the fun.

Old Council Building, Goolgowi

Council resolved to use grant money to repair the building and bring it to a useable state.

WATER AND SEWER NEWS

Melbergen Water Supply Scheme

Work is in progress to convert all meters to an automated meter reading system. Placing a small device beside the meter means Council can receive transmissions regarding water consumption.

Water Mains Replacement

Council have replaced 1,006m of PVC mains with Poly (HDPE) mains between Merriwagga and Goolgowi and 2,550m of PVC mains on Rankins Springs rural supply to improve water supply reliability.

New Fencing at Water Sites

The damaged fence at the Merriwagga and Mt Daylight pump stations has been repaired and 77m of new fencing has been installed at Goolgowi Sewer Ponds.

Pave and Seal Works

Council have begun pave and seal works on Carrathool Road, Lachlan River Road and The Springs Road.

These works are expected to take place until the Christmas Holidays (weather depending).

During this period drivers are asked to exercise caution when driving through the road work area and to be prepared for some minor delays.
