OLD CARRATHOOL SHIRE COUNCIL CHAMBERS - GOOLGOWI

In 2021, after being vacant for almost 20 years, Carrathool Shire Council undertook renovation works on the old Carrathool Shire Council Chambers building in Goolgowi. The building restoration work is almost complete. The aim of the project was to make the building safe and secure and was made possible by grant funding to Council from the NSW Government.

General Manager Rick Warren said today that "Now that work is almost complete Council welcomes any enquires from local groups who may want to use this significant community assets with strong links to our past"

Work on the building included; a new roof, veranda, painting, electrical re-wiring, carpet cleaning and replacement, and the addition of air-conditioning.


