At the February meeting, Council resolved to provide promotion and necessary traffic control to the amount of \$1,500 for the 2021 Hillston Outback Triathlon event. As well as providing traffic control for the 2021 ANZAC Day March.

Hillston Caravan Park Upgrades

Council moved to submit an application to the Building Better Regions Fund for the provision of two new cabins (one being accessible) and a three unit cabin (motel style accommodation).

It was also noted that Council has received a further grant to the value of \$97,400 under the Crown Reserves Improvement Fund for the purpose of upgrading the Hillston Caravan Park amenities to the rear of the park.

Mobile Library Truck

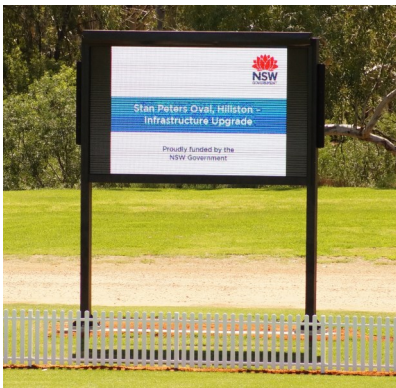
A report was received by Council on the successful State Libraries grant of \$196,000 to replace the Carrathool / Narrandera Mobile Library Truck.

Stage one of the Carrathool Road Pave and Seal is now complete with 5km of the road finished. Stage 2, consisting of another 5km of seal has now commenced and will be completed in the coming months.

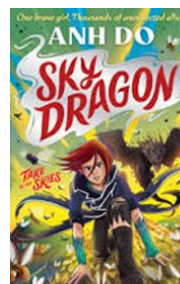
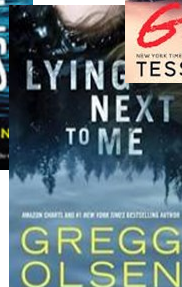
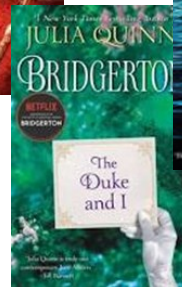
