NSW PLANNING PORTAL
From 1 July, Development Applications can only be lodged via the NSW Planning Portal and not directly with Council.

That means all forms of development applications must be lodged online via the NSW Planning portal at planningportal.nsw.gov.au

The move online is mandatory for Councils and is a requirement of the NSW Government.

To make lodgement as easy as possible, Council has a dedicated Planning Kiosk at both the Council Chambers, Goolgowi and the Hillston District Office where customers can lodge an application with the assistance of staff.

Residents are encouraged to make use of the portal which is now live.

Qualification for Enrolment as a non-resident elector

In order to qualify for enrolment on the non-residential roll as a non-residential owner a person must be the owner or nominated by the owner or owners of rateable land in the area. The relevant forms are available at the Goolgowi Council Chambers and Hillston District Office and from the Website: www.carrathool.nsw.gov.au

Claims for enrolment as an non-residential elector must be received by the General Manager before 6pm (EST) Monday 26 July 2021.

2021 NSW Local Government Elections will be held on Saturday 4 September, 2021. the elections are being conducted by the NSW Electoral Commission—Not by Council.

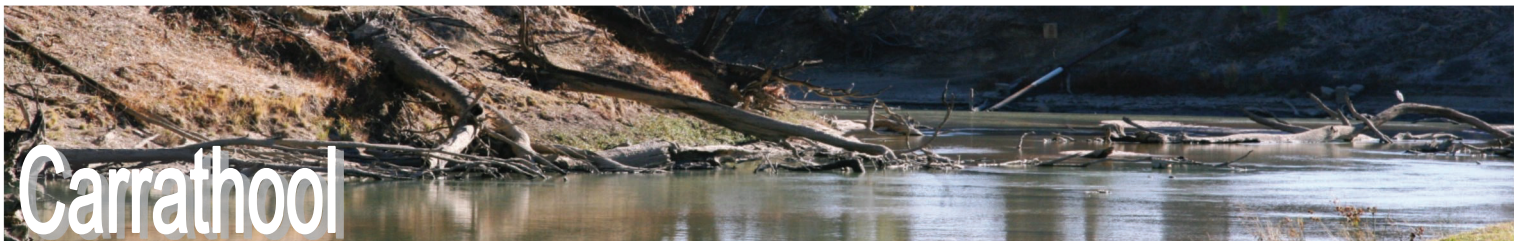
The following information shows the key dates for potential candidates.

- 28 June 2021 — The nominations online Management System is available to prospective candidates
- 26 July 2021 — Lodgement of Nominations Opens. Close of role for the purpose of being a candidate, or nominator.
- 4 August 2021 — Close of nominations and close of candidates and groups.
- 23 August 2021 — Pre poll voting opens.
- 4 September 2021 — Election Day

MEETING MATTERS

The assessments of Council's Roads to determine the suitability of roads for heavy vehicle use has been completed. During the meeting held 22 June, Council resolved to make a final determination to nominate roads suitable for heavy access to the National Heavy Vehicle Regulator (NHVR) for inclusion in the approved network in time for the 2021 harvest period.

Council considered all submissions received concerning the Voluntary Planning Agreement in regard to the Daisy Hill Solar farm before adopting the Agreement.

Council approved the following projects for submission under Fixing Local Roads round 3 in the following priority:

1. Carrathool Road – Pave & Seal - \$2,500,000 co-contribution of \$400,000 from Roads to Recovery and \$225,000 from Council Road Reserve.
2. Lachlan River Road – Pave & Seal - \$1,031,250 co-contribution of \$343,750 from Roads to Recovery.
3. Mt Grace Road – Resheet \$446,250 co-contribution of \$148,750 from Roads to Recovery.

INFRASTRUCTURE NEWS

ROAD CLOSURES

Due to adverse weather conditions Council has had to close unsealed roads more often and for longer periods, this is done for a reason.

Council staff have had many phone calls from truck drivers and travellers for help after becoming bogged on Closed Roads.

It is not Council or its staffs responsibility to pull you out of a bog when you drive on a Closed Road. (First responders are exempt in an emergency, as are local residents who need to travel for essential purposes).

The penalties in place are **\$1,350.00 per kilometre** for road damage caused by vehicles to a closed road.

Please make people aware especially travellers or transport drivers that may be taking "the shortest route". That short cut for them could be making long term defects for you.
