Council would like to inform the public that the Hillston Aerodrome runaway is planning to be re-sealed on 30 November 2021 for approximately one day (weather depending). Within this period the Aerodrome will remain closed except for emergency situations.

#### **TEMPORARY ROAD CLOSURE** BACK HILLSTON / TYSOSN ROAD

Back Hillston Road and Tysons Road will be temporarily closed to traffic on Monday 29 November 2021 to Friday 3 December 2021 due to installation of underground pipelines.

Access to Back Hillston Road from Kidman Way, Tysons Road, Bretags Road and Dumossa Road will be impacted. Road users are asked to please follow the traffic control processes in place.

## **UPCOMING ROAD WORKS - CARRATHOOL ROAD**

Work commencement of culvert installation for sealing / upgrading Carrathool Road 11.5km (from intersection of Murrumbidgee River Road) has been scheduled to begin Wednesday 10 November 2021 and expected to last until Friday 31 December 2021.

During this time traffic restrictions will be in place and road users are asked to be cautious when travelling in the Carrathool village area and to adhere to all road traffic signs.
