Council has assisted a local historian in compiling a comprehensive narrative of historic interments as a result of tragedy, in various public and private cemeteries within the southern parts of the Shire. ## **RESTRICTED HEAVY VEHICLE ACCESS**

After consultation with road users and an assessment of its roads network Council nominated most of its roads to the NHVR as suitable for restricted vehicle use. These roads are now approved for use by vehicles up to 36.5 meters, except as outlined below:

- Road train length must not exceed 36.5m
- · Vehicles must comply with load limits for the combination
- Dry weather access only
- Operators to inform themselves of road condition
- Damage to infrastructure will be the liability of the operator
- 60km/h speed limit on all roads

Children will get a library bag at the first 25 books, and then will receive an iron-on badge for every 200 books read, with a final prize for reaching a 1000 books read.




