At the April meeting Council resolved to waive the fees for the use of the Hillston Community Hall for the Breast Cancer Awareness Fundraiser held on the 26 March 2022.

A request was received from the Hillston RSL Sub Branch asking permission to install a stone tablet detailing Hillston residents who served their country following WW2. Council have granted the request and permitted installation of the plaque.

### Australia Day 2023 to be held in Goolgowi

Council resolved to endorse the proposed Australia Day Event for 2023, to be held in Goolgowi. Council also resolved to consider the current list of award categories and finalise the categories.

Moving forward the Junior Citizen of the Year and Young Citizen of the year will be combined into one category of Young Citizen of the year.

### INFRASTRUCTURE NEWS

#### Water Tower Relining

Council has successfully secured the funding to reline the water tower at James Woods Park, Hillston to address the leakage issue.

Council would like to advise all residents to take extra precautions around the worksite.

Council is required to isolate the water tower from the system to be able to undertake this work and will try to make sure water is supplied uninterrupted.

Council expects work to be completed by the end of May.
