COMMUNITY CONSULTATION

Council are looking to design a pump track at Settlers Park, Goolgowi and will be seeking funding to build the project.

Pump tracks are circuits used by bikes or even skates or scooters with mounding and turns which allow riders to use body movements to 'pump' or gather momentum around the track.

These adventure play spaces are very popular and help children and young people build self-confidence, learn skills, and provide a positive social outlet. These sports are also a great way to exercise, benefiting health and wellbeing.

MEETING MATTERS

Fixing Local Roads Round 4

Applications for funding under round 4 Fixing Local Roads have once again opened with Council nominating various unsealed roads throughout the Shire that are in need of gravel resheeting for a total of \$2.4 million.

Policy Update

At the August meeting Council re-adopted Policy 069 Aerodromes - Grazing Rights and Policy 157 Level of Road Service unchanged.

Council moved to place the draft Private Works and Supply of Materials Policy 121 on public exhibition for 28 days adopting the policy after the exhibition period if no submissions are received.

INFRASTRUCTURE NEWS

Hillston Heavy Vehicle Bypass - Overtaking Lane Council will be undertaking a 350m section of road construction on the Cowper Street/The Springs Road intersection. Works are scheduled to take approx. 9 days (weather permitting).

During this period drivers are asked to exercise caution when driving through the road work area and to be prepared for some minor delays.

WATER AND SEWER NEWS

The council plans to undertake relining work on Charles Street and Grattan Street sewer mains. These sewer mains were constructed around 1978 and some defects were identified during the camera inspection. Primary CCTV (camera) examination will be carried out on the 24th and 25th of August, with relining work expected to commence at the end of October.


Most classes throughout Carrathool Shire have entered something in the display, all based on the nominated Children's Book week books. The result is fantastic.
