MEDIA RELEASES THE GOVERNMENT NEEDS TO BE TOLD NATURAL DISASTER DAMAGE SURVEY

18/11/2022

Carrathool Shire was declared a natural disaster area on the 22 August 2022. This declaration allows for concessional loans and household assistance for eligible residents.

This declaration was upgraded to include a primary producer grant on the 4 November 2022. In order to give the government an indication of production losses and infrastructure damage across the Shire, farmers are asked to complete a short survey, the link for the online survey can be found on the homepage of Council's website: www.carrathool.nsw.gov.au.

This survey is not used for individual assistance rather it will give the Government an overview of what damage this event has caused Shire wide.

At this stage only estimates are needed to complete the form. All farmers within the Shire who have been affected by flooding or recent rain events need to complete this survey.

Examples of losses include stock, fencing and downgraded quality of the forthcoming harvest.

I encourage all farmers in the Shire to complete the survey as the total loss for our Shire will be used to unlock grant funding for your business.

Whilst the survey is not an application for a grant, completion of the survey could benefit your business with initial grants of up to \$25,000.

With natural disasters occurring over much of NSW, we need to keep Carrathool Shire at the forefront of Government departments as they calculate any grant assistance.

The Government needs to be told how great your farming losses are and what affect this event will have on your business enterprise.

FLOOD INFORMATION 28/11/2022

Mayor Darryl Jardine wants to reassure residents of Hillston that the Council have been undertaking flood preparation activities and monitoring water levels along the Lachlan River.

Cr Jardine said "Council has been working with the local SES Controller on a range of activities over the past few weeks preparing for any eventuality. Each organisation has different roles with the SES designated the combat agency for flood events in NSW."

The mayor further stated "Council staff have been removing obstructions to ensure the water flows through floodways as intended and away from the town."

The SES website www.ses.nsw.gov.au provides a great deal of further information. Flood alerts are found on this website and copies are available at the Council office of the latest notifications. Should any circumstance change the SES will notify the public.
