Sponsorship Opportunity

The Community Development Officer spoke with Council regarding a sponsorship opportunity.

The project being proposed is the purchase of several pedal boats and small row boats for use in Lake Woorabinda. The purchase and initial use for the boats will coincide with the Lake Woorabinda Festival being planned for March 2023.

Following this it is proposed to allow local community groups to utilise the boats to assist in fundraising efforts.

ALLIGATOR WEED AWARENESS

Alligator weed is an extremely fast spreading weed with a preferred growth in water but also on land, it has the potential to have extreme impacts on primary production being harmful for stock and being extremely invasive for crop growers.

This year Alligator Weed is posing an increased risk to primary producers of the Carrathool Shire in the Tabbita, Carrathool and Western Gunbar regions.

If your property has channels or water flow from the following: Wah Wah, Barren Box or Mirrol channels, creeks and waterways, the risk primarily applies to you. If you see this Weed please contact Carrathool Shire Council and/or Murrumbidgee Irrigation to seek help to eradicate the threat to the Riverina.






