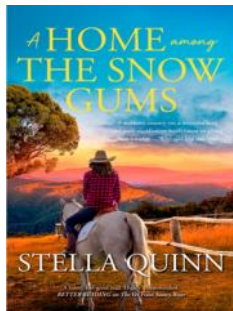

Faxed quotations will **not** be considered. The highest / lowest for any quotation will not necessarily be accepted.

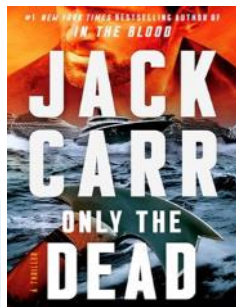

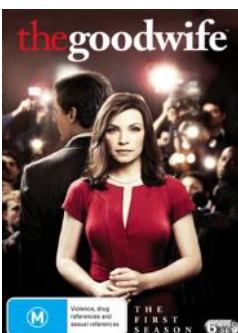
