STATE GOVERNMENT VISIT

The Deputy Premier of NSW the Hon. Paul Toole MP visited Goolgowi on Monday afternoon and made a major announcement about rural and regional internet connectivity.

The State Government in conjunction with NBN Co. have joined forces to enable 46 sites across the state (approximately 11,000 customers) to be able to access broadband internet.

This will be an important investment for business, including home businesses, students and social well being.

There will be a tower based at Goolgowi which will provide service to a radius of approximately 30kms which will include Tabbita, Goolgowi and Merriwagga. It is expected to be much

cheaper than the current satellite providers with the ability to have unlimited data plans.

The service is expected to be up and running in approximately two years.

ANIMAL REGISTRATION

Do you know your responsibilities as a pet owner in NSW?

- Your animal must be microchipped by 12 weeks of age.
- Animals are to be lifetime registered by the age of 6 months.
- You MUST notify Council or the NSW Pet Registry if an animal is sold/missing or deceased.

RATES NOTICE EMAIL DATABASE


Council software now has the capability to email rate and water consumption notices. We are currently building our database to begin offering this service in the future.




Library Staff have been working on reproducing this popular local history book over the past months.
