Goolgowi:


March to start at 3:00pm, from the Goolgowi Public Hall down to the Cenotaph next to the Goolgowi Ex-Servicemen's Club.

Infrastructure News

Flood Damage Funding - Cannards Road culvert installations have been completed and is open to all traffic, along with Barry Scenic Drive gully erosion. Flood damage works have commenced on Lowlands Road and Lachlan Valley Way East.

Camerons Lane gravel resheets are underway, this is to compliment the Polytahr stabilisation treatment completed this year.

Council replaced and commissioned 1,5 kilometers of PVC water main successfully on the Melbergen Water Scheme.

Finance Facts

Cost Shifting from State Government to Local Councils. A report prepared for LGNSW for the 2021/22 finanacial year found that \$1.36 billion of expenses were passed onto Councils, averaging an extra \$460.67 for every rate payer across the state. 
