Hillston Water Tower Mural Project

The Community Development Officer provided Council with an update on the Hillston Water Tower Mural project.

As part of the process a committee was formed of Councillors, relevant staff and a representative for the community art groups. The committee met twice during August to review the 17 EOI submissions and recommend to Council a preferred artist.

The committee recommended that Janne Krimson Birkner be selected as the preferred artist and that contact be made with the artist to progress the project.

Janne Krimson Birkner has painted similar structures at Lockhart, Milbrulong and Tottenham.

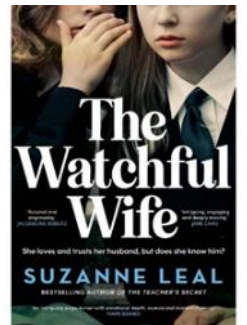
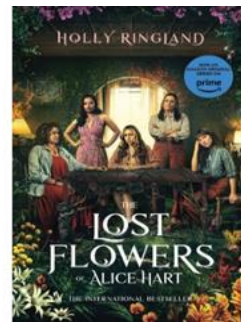
